## Latest iPod® Information

- There is a detailed User's Manual that accompanies the iPod Adapter Kit. Customers can find answers to their questions and see how the radio controls work with each radio model.
- Be sure you familiarize yourself with the customer brochure we prepared for the iPod Adapter. It spells out features and benefits.

### Compatibility

- The iPod Adapter works in 2002 and newer Audi models, except those with MMI – A8 after 2004, A6 after 2005, and Audi Q7.
- An Adapter for the excluded models with MMI is planned for early 2007 release.
- The iPod Adapter works with all generation 3 and newer iPod models with the standard bottom connector, except iPod shuffle.
- The iPod Adapter is not compatible with satellite radio, Phatbox, glovebox or trunk mounted CD changers.

### Operation

- With the vehicle ignition off, open the glovebox and plug the Adapter's connecting plug, with the logo pointing upwards, into the bottom of the iPod.
- The Audi logo appears in the iPod screen for a few seconds after connection.
- When connected to the iPod Adapter, the customer operates their iPod through the vehicle's radio system controls.
- The iPod controls are disabled when connected to the iPod Adapter.
- The iPod operates in the same way that a CD Changer operates. Using the controls, customers can forward, rewind, shuffle/random, and scan.
- The artist, track, album and genre information stored in the iPod is not processed by the Adapter, so track selection using these functions is not possible and this data is not displayed on the radio or the radio/navigation system.

- The iPod Adapter lets customer access up to five playlists and their complete iPod.
- Radio buttons 1-5 or CD +/- will access the first five playlists in their iPod. Radio button 6 or CD +/- will access the entire iPod as a playlist.
- When connected to the iPod Adapter, the iPod will automatically pause during any incoming or outgoing phone calls.

### **Charging**

- When connected to the iPod Adapter, the iPod battery will charge when the vehicle is running and the radio is on.
- If the customer connects their iPod and the screen is blank, the cause is most likely a very low iPod battery. When the battery has discharged to this extent, the iPod Adapter cannot recognize the iPod. Customers should plug their iPod into the charger that came with their iPod and charge it per the manufacturer's instructions.

### **Installation**

- iPod Adapter should be mounted behind the radio or glovebox.
- The customer should only see the attachment connector that is located in the glovebox.
- Full installation instructions come with each iPod Adapter Kit.

### **CAUTION**

Severe temperature fluctuations can harm an iPod. Tell your customers not to leave their iPod in the car if they are going to be away for an extended period of time.
